Print the PDF And fold the tract into a booklet to give away. Instruction on folding the Romans Road Tract Booklet below.

The booklet will be (4.25 x 3.75 in.) in size with eight pages using (8.5 x 11 in.) regular printing paper.

1st - Fold the paper in half lengthways (11 in.)

2nd - Starting at the marked FRONT picture, fold on the crease to halfway between B and C.

3rd - Take C and fold backwards to the right with the front page facing you.

4th - Take D and fold towards C - You have FINISHED your own Christian booklet tract to give away.

If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you

are saved. – Romans 10:9,10

First, we must believe the historical facts about Jesus Christ found in God's Word, the Bible: Jesus died on the cross for our sins, and God raised Him from the dead, giving Him an immortal body, the kind He has promised to give us when He returns from heaven to rule the earth.

Secondly, God wants each of us to make a confession with our mouths (out loud) that Jesus Christ is our personal Lord and Savior, and one day He is taking us to Heaven.

This is accomplished by praying the following prayer:

Dear Jesus, come into my heart. Forgive all my sins. Wash me in your blood. Write my name in your Book of Life. Fill me with Your Holy Spirit, so I can serve and obey You. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Sadly, when it comes to the subject
of making Heaven one's eternal

lead to Rome. Today it can mean
that the route or method one takes
to get somewhere isn't important,
as long as the journey reaches the
same destination.

A key to the success and longevity
of the Roman Empire was an
expansive system of roads. The
first proper Roman road, the
Applan Way, was constructed in
312 BC to provide fast, reliable
communications and supply links, in
ways with the well armed Samnites.
Historian Logan Thompson states,
"This route followed a remarkably
straight, direct, well-drained 122
mile course, firmly topped with
nearly fashioned blocks of volcanic
lava. It is commendable that Roman
engineers and surveyors managed,
to with their first-ever route, to
incorporate most of the construction
principles so closely followed during
the next 700 years. The latter, route
networks constantly expanded in
every direction, like the spokes
of a wheel, with Rome as a hub."
