

ROMANS ROAD METHODS 6-9

METHOD 6: SIMPLE PRESENTATION

First, start at Romans 3:10. *As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one;"*

Underline this verse and, in the margin, write, "The Road to Heaven Starts Here."

Then in the margin, write **Romans 3:23**.

Now turn to Romans 3:23:

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Again, in the margin, write **Romans 5:12**.

Now turn to Romans 5:12:

"Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned -"

And besides that verse, write Romans 5:8.

Now turn to Romans 5:8:

"But God demonstrates his own love toward us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Underline verse 8, and beside it write Romans 10:9-10; 13.

Now turn to Romans 10:9-10; 13:

"If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved." (Romans 10:9-10.)

"for, Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." Romans 10:13.)

METHOD 7: THE ROMANS ROAD MAP

The Romans Road Map.

You can follow this scriptural road map to heaven. You can use this Romans Road road map to share and lead others to heaven.

1. The Bible says that all have sinned in <u>Romans 3:10</u> and <u>Romans 3:23</u>.

It is our universal problem; all have sinned.

2. The price of sin is death and separation from God found in <u>Romans 5:12</u> and <u>Romans</u> <u>6:23</u>.

3. Jesus paid the price for our sins found in <u>Romans 5:8</u>.

God provided a way for our sins to be forgiven and never to be held against us any longer.

4. We personally accept and receive forgiveness and salvation through faith in Jesus Christ: <u>Romans 10:9-10,13</u>

Are you now willing and prepared to ask God to forgive you of your sins? And accept Jesus as your Savior, who paid the price for your sins?

5. Then pray this prayer or one similar.

Dear God, I believe Jesus Christ died on the cross, rose again, and became my Savior. Lord, I ask you to forgive me for my sins and come into my heart right now. Take me and make me a vessel that you want me to be. In Jesus' name, Amen.

6. The Bible teaches that you will go to hell if you die in your sins. But if you confess, turn (repent) from your sins, and accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord.

Jesus gives you the free gift of eternal life. Salvation brings and gives us peace with God. <u>Romans 5:1</u>, <u>Romans 8:1</u>, <u>Romans 8:38-39</u>.

This is the Romans Road Map To Heaven.

METHOD 8: THE ROMANS ROAD

Encourage you to memorize verses from the book of Romans to help you present the gospel message. Or mark in your Bible margin 1 to 7 scripture verses in your Bible for easy reference.

1. Romans 3:23: "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God..."

2. Romans 5:8: "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

3. Romans 6:23: "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

4. Romans 8:1: "Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."

5. Romans 10:9: "If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

6. Romans 10:10: "For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved."

7. Romans 10:13: "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

If possible, have the other person read the Bible verses for themselves. Ask them to tell you what each verse is saying to them. A lot more effective than you trying to tell them a lot of detail.

If the person is ready to respond to the Gospel presentation, re-read <u>Romans 10:9-10</u> and ask them to confess their sin and trust and faith in Christ through prayer. The prayer is simply an expression of the faith they have in their heart. Encourage them to talk to God in their own words. Or have a prayer like this below, written in the back of your Bible.

Dear God, I believe Jesus Christ died on the cross, rose again, and became my Savior. Lord, I ask you to forgive me for my sins and come into my heart right now. Take me and make me a vessel that you want me to be. In Jesus' name, Amen.

METHOD 9: THE ROMANS ROAD PLUS OTHER VERSES

How To Receive Christ As Lord And Savior!

Paul said he was in Romans 1:15, "That is why I am so eager to preach the gospel also to you who are in Rome." We have to be ready to preach the Gospel in a way that will answer people's life questions with scriptural answers. This will require you to spend time MEMORIZING BIBLE VERSES on salvation and studying how to present the passages that answer people's spiritual questions.

Study and memorize the plan of salvation in a seven-point outline form. For instance, remember or mark your Bible or use small cue cards with the verses written on them.

- 1. All sinners Romans 3:23.
- 2. Result death Romans 6:23.
- **3.** Heaven perfect <u>Revelation 21:27</u>.
- 4. Cannot earn Ephesians 2:8-9.
- 5. Christ paid and gives righteousness <u>2 Corinthians 5:21</u>; <u>Philippians 3:9</u>.
- 6. Only believe John 3:16.
- 7. Know you have eternal life I John 5:13.

This is one of the best methods of memorizing the scripture references and a few words to keep you on point. This will be exceedingly valuable when you witness to others, not that you will quote it precisely as you share. But in your mind, you will then be free to start off right in with the Gospel even when you are caught tongue-tied for lack of knowing what to say or nervous.

IMPORTANT

Soul-winners should use any Scriptural techniques that work in his or her witnessing. In business, memorizing the main points of what one wants to cover has been a successful method where person-to-person contact is required in any sales pitch. Always start with a quiet prayer trusting the Holy Spirit to work, leaving the results with God.

SUMMARY

All 9 Methods above are simple methods to share the Gospel with family, friends, and strangers. Pick one or two that work best for you.

<u>IMPORTANT DO PICK ONE</u> AND SEE HOW THE HOLY SPIRIT WILL USE YOU. Yes, you might not be perfect, but who is? You will make mistakes, just like everyone else. And that is OKAY. But remember and memorize this verse in Zechariah 4:6 says "So he said to me, "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: 'Not by might nor by power, <u>but by my Spirit</u>,' says the Lord Almighty."
